The cabinets are constructed from 25mm MDF, and extensive damping material is used throughout. The 740A and 740C need little introduction, as they have been the focus of many different reviews and



comparisons. With 100wpc and high current output stage, the 740A works a treat in this modest system. The 740C has dual Wolfson WM8740 DACs, and digital inputs, make this

## Hints & Tips.

Speaker positioning is a very important part of realising the full potential of your system. Most speakers prefer to be toed in a little, and be in an equilateral triangle with the listening position. This is the basics which most people understand. Speakers also like to be as far away from walls as possible, as the walls add unwanted reflections which blur imaging, add harshness, and simply create an unnatural sound which isn't true to how the speaker should sound. Leaving a generous space between the front wall and side walls allows speakers to operate in a more anechoic state. There is almost no limit to how far a pair of speakers can be pushed into a room, excepting for tripping over the buggers! The main thing is to experiment with placement as much as possible as it costs nothing to move speakers around. The difference is even greater than trying new speakers.
